

## My Heart Faints Within Me

“For I know that my Redeemer and Vindicator lives, And at the last He will take His stand upon the earth. Even after my [mortal] skin is destroyed [by death], Yet from my [immortal] flesh I will see God, Whom I, even I, will see for myself, And my eyes will see Him and not another! My heart faints within me.”

~Job 19:25-27 AMP

Have you ever read a piece of scripture and out of the blue you just wept?

It happens to me once in a while...

**“O God of my life, I’m lovesick for you in this weary wilderness. I thirst with the deepest longings to love you more, with cravings in my heart that can’t be described. Such yearning grips my soul for you, my God!”**

**Psalms 63:1 TPT**

I read that verse above from Job just the other day, kind of randomly actually and the Spirit just overtook me and I found myself in tears. I think because of the overwhelming heartfelt message that Job is sharing with us here...

**“For it is my Father’s will that all who see his Son and believe in him should have eternal life. I will raise them up at the last day.”**

**John 6:40 NLT**

I can, and do feel Job’s passion. I felt “my heart faint within me” just like Job at the thought of his wonderful words coming to life...

**“For the Lord himself will appear with the declaration of victory, the shout of an archangel, and the trumpet blast of God. He will descend from the heavenly realm and command those who are dead in Christ to rise first. Then we who are alive will join them, transported together in clouds to have an encounter with the Lord in the air, and we will be forever joined with the Lord.”**

**1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 TPT**

Scripture is alive and it’s meant to speak to us. It’s meant to take control of us at times I believe...

**“I’m energized every time I enter your heavenly sanctuary to seek more of your power and drink in more of your glory.”**

**Psalms 63:2 TPT**

To think about that wonderful day when God comes to live with His people is such an emotional and hope filled moment for us to relate to...

**“I heard a loud shout from the throne, saying, “Look, God’s home is now among his people! He will live with them, and they will be his people. God himself will be with them.”**

**Revelation 21:3 NLT**

The Spirit was most definitely at work within Job when He wrote that passage and is at work in us when we are reading it. We need to be aware and receptive to His leading when we read all scripture...

**He (The Spirit) will glorify me on the earth, for he will receive from me what is mine and reveal it to you.”**

**John 16:14 TPT**

Whether it's learning something new or giving praise to God. Whether it's singing with psalms or getting advice from Solomon...

**"Let the word of Christ live in you richly, flooding you with all wisdom. Apply the Scriptures as you teach and instruct one another with the Psalms, and with festive praises, and with prophetic songs given to you spontaneously by the Spirit, so sing to God with all your hearts!"**

**Colossians 3:16 TPT**

Whether it's a lesson in history or it's weeping as your heart faints within you along with Job's. There is always a connection to be found...

**"Such things were written in the Scriptures long ago to teach us. And the Scriptures give us hope and encouragement as we wait patiently for God's promises to be fulfilled."**

**Romans 15:4 NLT**

My prayer for us today is that we are open and waiting for The Holy Spirit to work within us as we read God's Word. May we see, hear and feel what God wants us to in that moment as the scripture comes alive within us...

**"And now we look back on all this and thank God, an artesian well of thanks! When you got the Message of God we preached, you didn't pass it off as just one more human opinion, but you took it to heart as God's true word to you, which it is, God himself at work in you believers!"**
