It seems lately that everywhere I turn psalm 119 is popping up during my day and what a wonderful psalm it is...

“Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.”

Psalms 119:105 AMP

Some of my favorite Bible verses are found in Psalm 119. I probably love it so much because it's all centered around God's Word and how great it is...

“Every Scripture has been inspired by the Holy Spirit, the breath of God. It will empower you by its instruction and correction, giving you the strength to take the right direction and lead you deeper into the path of godliness.”

Matthew 24:35 TPT
